3 FOR the purpose of requiring that if a health insurance policy provides certain

- 4 coverage for treatment of mental illness at a hospital or residential treatment
- 5 facility for children of a certain age, the policy's coverage must extend from the
- 6 date of admission to the date when the child becomes potentially eligible for
- 7 reimbursement under Medicaid; and generally relating to the insurance
- 8 coverage period for children who are receiving treatment for mental illness.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 IF A HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR INPATIENT

19 TREATMENT OF ACUTE OR CHRONIC MENTAL ILLNESS AT A HOSPITAL OR

20 RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT FACILITY FOR CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS,

21 THE COVERAGE MUST EXTEND FROM THE DATE OF ADMISSION TO THE HOSPITAL OR

22 FACILITY TO THE DATE WHEN THE CHILD BECOMES POTENTIALLY ELIGIBLE FOR

23 COVERAGE UNDER THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 October 1, 2002.
