A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Workers' Compensation - Absences for Compensable Injury - Prohibition**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an employer from disciplining or penalizing a covered
4 employee for absences resulting from a compensable work related injury; and
5 generally relating to workers' compensation.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Labor and Employment**

14 9-1105.

15 (a) An employer may not discharge a covered employee from employment
16 solely because the covered employee files a claim for compensation under this title.

17 (b) AN EMPLOYER MAY NOT DISCIPLINE OR PENALIZE A COVERED EMPLOYEE
18 FOR ABSENCES RESULTING FROM A COMPENSABLE WORK RELATED INJURY.

19 (C) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on
20 conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500 or imprisonment not exceeding 1
21 year or both.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2002.
