- 4 FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study Exclusion of Watercraft from
- 5 Wildlife Habitats in Waterfront Communities; specifying the membership and
- duties of the Task Force; providing for the appointment of a chairperson of the
- 7 Task Force; providing for staffing of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to
- 8 report to the Governor and the General Assembly; providing for the termination
- 9 of this Act; and generally relating to the establishment of a Task Force to Study
- 10 Exclusion of Watercraft from Wildlife Habitats in Waterfront Communities.
- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That:
- 13 (a) There is a Task Force to Study the Exclusion of Watercraft from Wildlife
- 14 Habitats in Waterfront Communities.
- 15 (b) The Task Force consists of the following 5 members, appointed by the 16 Governor:
- 17 (1) Two members of the Senate of Maryland; and
- 18 (2) Three members of the House of Delegates.
- 19 (c) The Governor shall designate the chairman of the Task Force.
- 20 (d) The Department of Natural Resources shall provide staff for the Task
- 21 Force.
- 22 (e) On completion of the study, the Task Force shall report its findings and
- 23 recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly, in accordance with §
- 24 2-1246 of the State Government Article.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 2002. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of
- 27 September 30, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this
- 28 Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
