Prince George's County - Roadside Solicitation - Minors <u>Children</u> PG 418-02

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a minor child under a certain age in Prince George's

- 5 County from standing in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit
- 6 money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle; prohibiting an
- 7 adult in Prince George's County from causing, encouraging, allowing, or
- 8 petitioning a minor certain child to stand in a roadway, median divider, or
- 9 intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a
- 10 vehicle; providing a certain exception to finding a minor certain child guilty or
- 11 adjudicating a minor certain child as delinquent for a violation of this Act; and
- 12 generally relating to roadside solicitation in Prince George's County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

HOUSE BILL 948 Article - Transportation 2 21-507. (a) Except for the occupant of a disabled vehicle who seeks the aid of another 4 vehicle, a person may not stand in a roadway to solicit a ride, employment, or 5 business from the occupant of any vehicle. A person may not stand on or near a highway to solicit any other person to (b) 7 watch or guard any vehicle while it is parked or about to be parked on a highway. In Charles County, a person may not stand in a roadway, median divider, (c) 9 or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a 10 vehicle. (D) (1)IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY: A MINOR CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 15 YEARS MAY NOT STAND (I) 13 IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR INTERSECTION TO SOLICIT MONEY OR 14 DONATIONS OF ANY KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE; AND

15 AN ADULT MAY NOT CAUSE, ENCOURAGE, ALLOW, OR PETITION (II)16 A MINOR CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 15 YEARS TO STAND IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN 17 DIVIDER, OR INTERSECTION TO SOLICIT MONEY OR DONATIONS OF ANY KIND FROM 18 THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE.

19 (2)A MINOR CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 15 YEARS MAY NOT BE FOUND 20 GUILTY OR ADJUDICATED DELINQUENT FOR A VIOLATION OF PARAGRAPH (1)(I) OF 21 THIS SUBSECTION IF AN ADULT CAUSED, ENCOURAGED, ALLOWED, OR PETITIONED 22 THE MINOR CHILD IN VIOLATION OF PARAGRAPH (1)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 2002.
