A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Board of Education - Districts**  
3 **PG 414-02**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the school board districts of Prince George's County to be  
5 coterminous with the councilmanic districts of Prince George's County;  
6 providing that one member be elected from each councilmanic district; making  
7 this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the Prince George's  
8 County Board of Education.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
2 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 3-1001 of Article - Education of the Annotated Code of  
3 Maryland be repealed.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland  
5 read as follows:

6 **Article - Education**

7 3-1001.

8 THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD DISTRICTS ARE COTERMINOUS  
9 WITH THE NINE COUNCILMANIC DISTRICTS AS ADOPTED BY THE PRINCE GEORGE'S  
10 COUNTY COUNCIL AND REVIEWED AND CERTIFIED BY THE PRINCE GEORGE'S  
11 COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS OR THEIR DESIGNEES AS PART OF THE 2000 CENSUS  
12 REDISTRICTING DATA PROGRAM AND EACH DECENNIAL CENSUS REDISTRICTING  
13 DATA PROGRAM THEREAFTER.

15 (a) In this subtitle, "elected member" means one of the nine elected members  
16 of the Prince George's County Board or a member appointed to fill a vacancy of one of  
17 these nine members.

18 (b) The Prince George's County Board consists of 10 MEMBERS AS FOLLOWS:

19 (1) [nine] ONE elected [members] MEMBER FROM EACH OF THE NINE  
20 COUNCILMANIC DISTRICTS; and

21 (2) [one] ONE student member selected under subsection (f)(2) of this  
22 section.

23 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an  
24 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health  
25 or safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the  
26 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take  
27 effect from the date it is enacted.
