FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement in Chapter 607 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2001, Talbot County - Oxford Community Services Building Loan of 2001, that the grantee grant and convey a certain easement to the Maryland Historical Trust; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the Talbot County - Oxford Community Services Building Loan of 2001.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
14 Chapter 607 of the Acts of 2001
15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That:
17 [(6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey 18 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of 19 its interest:
20 (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;

- 1 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic 2 structures.
- 3 (b) If the grantee or beneficiary of the grant holds a lease on the land 4 and structures, the Trust may accept an easement on the leasehold interest.
- 5 (c) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust 6 and any liens or encumbrances against the land or the structures must be acceptable 7 to the Trust.]
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an
- 9 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health
- 10 or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the
- 11 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take
- 12 effect from the date it is enacted.
