4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Developmental Disabilities Administration from

5 retaining cost-of-living increases in the Supplemental Security Income of

6 individuals receiving residential or day program services provided by the

7 Administration for a developmental disability; requiring the Administration to

8 add the cost-of-living increase to the individual's personal needs allowance;

9 defining a certain term; <u>allowing the Administration to use certain funds from</u>

10 the Waiting List Equity Fund for certain purposes; requiring the Administration

11 to reimburse a certain fund; providing for the termination of this Act; making

12 this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the Developmental

13 Disabilities Administration and the Supplemental Security Income increases

14 received by individuals with developmental disabilities.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an

23 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health

24 or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the

25 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take

26 effect from the date it is enacted. It shall remain effective through June 30, 2003, and,

27 at the end of June 30, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly,

28 this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

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
