A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Environment - State Radon Contact - Public Information**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment to appoint a  
4 member of the Department to serve as the State radon contact and liaison to the  
5 United States Environmental Protection Agency; requiring the Department to  
6 make available to the public upon request certain information regarding radon  
7 gas and the names of certain radon testing and mitigation service providers; and  
8 generally relating to a State radon contact and liaison to the United States  
9 Environmental Protection Agency and radon testing.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - Environment**

18 8-305.

19 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

20 (2) "Listed facility" means a radon testing facility that is listed in the  
21 report of the latest round of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's  
22 National Radon Measurement Proficiency Program.

23 (3) (i) "Radon testing device" means a device that:

24 1. Collects radon or radon progeny; and
