- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 2. Upon completion of the probationary period, shall be 2 subject to the Cecil County personnel regulations and policies in all matters.
- 3 [(vii)] (VIII) Nothing in this subsection shall affect the rights and 4 protections accorded an employee under any other provision of law.
- 5 (2) The County Commissioners shall pay the cost of all necessary 6 expenses incurred by the Sheriff and his staff.
- 7 (3) The Sheriff of Cecil County shall have the authority to formulate and
- 8 administer a plan that includes the method of supervision to use inmates the Sheriff
- 9 deems eligible and selects to perform, under the supervision of State, county, or
- 10 municipal employees, tasks the Sheriff assigns within the county or any incorporated
- 11 municipality within the county.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
- 13 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
- 14 apply to the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Cecil County in office on the
- 15 effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
- 16 compensation of the Sheriff of Cecil County shall take effect at the beginning of the
- 17 next following term of office.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 19 October 1, 2002.
