- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 SUBTITLE 15A. MARYLAND TEACHER LOAN REPAYMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

- 25 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 26 INDICATED.
- 27 (B) "ELIGIBLE EMPLOYMENT" MEANS EMPLOYMENT IN THE STATE AS A

- 1 (1) A TITLE I SCHOOL;
- 2 (2) A RECONSTITUTED SCHOOL;
- 3 (3) A RECONSTITUTION ELIGIBLE SCHOOL; OR
- 4 (4) AN INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM IN A SUBJECT AREA THAT THE STATE
- 5 SUPERINTENDENT DESIGNATES AS A CRITICAL PERSONNEL SHORTAGE AREA.
- 6 (C) "HIGHER EDUCATION LOAN" MEANS ANY LOAN FOR UNDERGRADUATE OR
- 7 GRADUATE STUDY THAT IS OBTAINED FOR TUITION, EDUCATIONAL EXPENSES, OR
- 8 LIVING EXPENSES FROM:
- 9 (1) A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY, GOVERNMENT, OR COMMERCIAL

- 17 (A) THERE IS A MARYLAND TEACHER LOAN REPAYMENT ASSISTANCE
- 18 PROGRAM IN THE STATE.

- 20 SHALL ASSIST IN THE REPAYMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION LOANS OWED BY AN

- 2 (A) LOAN ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE IN THE AMOUNT OF 3 UP TO:
- 4 (1) 10 PERCENT PER YEAR OF THE TOTAL HIGHER EDUCATION LOANS 5 OWED BY AN ELIGIBLE RECIPIENT; AND
- 6 (2) A MAXIMUM AGGREGATE TOTAL OF \$8,000.
- 7 (B) A PERSON MAY RECEIVE LOAN ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE FOR A 8 MAXIMUM OF 4 YEARS.
