A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Cecil County - Town of Rising Sun Historical Museum and Visitors Center**
3 **Loan of 1999**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the date by which the grantee is required to provide a
5 matching fund, pursuant to Chapter 294 of the Acts of the General Assembly of
6 1999, Cecil County - Town of Rising Sun Historical Museum and Visitors Center
7 Loan of 1999, from June 1, 2001 to June 1, 2003; and generally relating to the
8 Cecil County - Town of Rising Sun Historical Museum and Visitors Center Loan
9 of 1999.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
11 Chapter 294 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1999
12 Section 1(5)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Chapter 294 of the Acts of 1999**

16 SECTION 1. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

17 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
18 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
19 matching fund of \$50,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided,
20 either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
21 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of in kind contributions. The fund
22 may consist of real property or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act.
23 In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets
24 may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter
25 and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, [2001] 2003, to
26 present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will
27 be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to
28 the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes
29 provided in this Act.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 June 1, 2002.
