- 3 (a) A police department [may] SHALL take any abandoned vehicle into
- 4 custody. For this purpose, the police department may use its own personnel,
- 5 equipment, and facilities or, subject to the provisions of subsection (b) of this section,
- 6 use other persons, equipment, and facilities for removing, preserving, and storing
- 7 abandoned vehicles.
- 8 (b) A police department may not authorize the use of a tow truck under 9 subsection (a) of this section unless the tow truck is registered under § 13-920 of this 10 article.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 12 effect October 1, 2002.
