SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OFMARYLAND, That:					
	16 (a) There is a Task Force to Study the Use of Chlorine in the Treatment of17 Drinking Water.				
18	(b) The task force shall consist of the following members:				
19 20	(1) two members of the Maryland House of Delegates appointed by the Speaker of the House;				
21 22	(2) two members of the Senate of Maryland appointed by the President of the Senate;				
23 24	(3) three persons appointed by the Secretary of the Environment, including one representative from the Water Quality Monitoring Division;				
25 26	(4) two persons representing public water systems in the State, appointed by the Governor; and				
27 28	(5) two persons of the general public with expertise in the treatment of public drinking water, appointed by the Governor.

12 (e) A member of the task force:

13 (1)may not receive compensation; but

14 is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State (2)15 Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

(f) The Department of the Environment shall provide staff support for the 16 17 task force.

18 The task force shall issue a final report of its findings and (g)

19 recommendations to the Governor and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government 20 Article, to the General Assembly on or before May 31, 2003.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 21

22 effect June 1, 2002. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of

23 May 31, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall

24 be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

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
