- 7 SUMMER SESSION AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK.
- 8 (3) "CONSUMER PRICE INDEX" MEANS THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX 9 (ALL URBAN CONSUMERS UNITED STATES CITY AVERAGE ALL ITEMS) FOR THE
- 10 YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31 AS PUBLISHED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR
- 11 BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS.
- 12 (4) "TUITION" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 13-701 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 13 (B) THE BOARD OF REGENTS MAY NOT APPROVE, AND THE UNIVERSITY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK MAY NOT IMPOSE, AN INCREASE IN THE TUITION AND
- 15 MANDATORY FEES CHARGED FOR AN ACADEMIC YEAR TO A RESIDENT
- 16 UNDERGRADUATE OR GRADUATE STUDENT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND.
- 17 COLLEGE PARK THAT EXCEEDS THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR THE PRECEDING
