- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a public school to allow certain nonenrolled students
- 5 to participate in certain extracurricular activities under certain circumstances;
- 6 requiring public schools to give placement priority to certain students over
- 7 certain students if certain limitations exist in certain extracurricular activities;
- 8 defining a certain term; and generally relating to allowing home-schooled and
 - private school students to participate in public school sponsored extracurricular

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY" INCLUDES
- 21 INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS, MUSIC, OR DRAMA PROGRAMS, STUDENT
- 22 ORGANIZATIONS, OR OTHER PROGRAMS SPONSORED BY A SCHOOL:
- 23 (1) IN WHICH A STUDENT MAY PARTICIPATE OUTSIDE OF REGULAR
- 24 SCHOOL HOURS: AND
- 25 (2) FOR WHICH A STUDENT DOES NOT EARN ACADEMIC CREDIT.
- 26 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A PUBLIC
- 27 SCHOOL MAY ALLOW A STUDENT WHO IS NOT ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL TO
- 28 PARTICIPATE IN AN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY SPONSORED BY THE SCHOOL TO

- 1 THE SAME EXTENT THAT A STUDENT WHO IS ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL MAY
- 2 PARTICIPATE IN THE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY, IF THE NONENROLLED
- 3 STUDENT:
- 4 (1) (I) PARTICIPATES IN A HOME INSTRUCTION PROGRAM UNDER
- 5 WRITTEN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT; AND
- 6 (II) IS ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND THE PUBLIC SCHOOL; OR
- 7 (2) (I) IS ENROLLED IN A PRIVATE SCHOOL THAT DOES NOT SPONSOR
- 8 THE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY; AND
- 9 (II) IS ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND THE PUBLIC SCHOOL.
- 10 (C) A PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL GIVE PLACEMENT PRIORITY TO ANY STUDENT
- 11 ENROLLED IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SPONSORING THE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY
- 12 OVER ANY NONENROLLED HOME-SCHOOLED OR PRIVATE SCHOOL STUDENT IF
- 13 THERE ARE A LIMITED NUMBER OF SPACES AVAILABLE FOR STUDENTS IN THE
- 14 EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 2002.
