A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Resource Recovery Facilities - Restriction**  
3 **PG/MC 126-02**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the approval of certain transfer stations and resource  
5 recovery facilities in Prince George's County that are accessible from certain  
6 roadways.

7 BY adding to  
8 Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission  
9 Section 8-110.3  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (1997 Replacement Volume and 2001 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission**

15 8-110.3.

16 APPROVAL MAY NOT BE GRANTED UNDER THIS ARTICLE FOR A TRANSFER  
17 STATION OR RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITY LOCATED IN PRINCE GEORGE'S  
18 COUNTY AND THAT:

19 (1) IS ACCESSIBLE FROM A RESIDENTIAL ROADWAY, AS DEFINED IN  
20 REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES OF THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY DEPARTMENT  
21 OF PUBLIC WORKS; OR

22 (2) (I) IS ACCESSIBLE FROM A COLLECTOR ROADWAY, AS DEFINED IN  
23 REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES OF THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY DEPARTMENT  
24 OF PUBLIC WORKS; AND

25 (II) REQUIRES THE USE OF MORE THAN 1,000 FEET OF COLLECTOR  
26 ROADWAY FOR ACCESS TO THE STATION OR FACILITY.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
2 July 1, 2002.
