1 AN ACT concerning 2 Sales and Use Tax - Exemption - Aquaculturally Raised Oysters 3 FOR the purpose of providing for an exemption from the sales and use tax for the sale of certain items relating to aquaculturally raised oysters; defining certain 4 5 terms; and generally relating to a sales and use tax exemption for the sale of 6 items relating to aquaculturally raised oysters. 7 BY adding to Article - Tax - General 8 9 Section 11-229 10 Annotated Code of Maryland (1997 Replacement Volume and 2001 Supplement) 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 Article - Tax - General 15 11-229. IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING TERMS HAVE THE MEANINGS 16 (A) (1)17 INDICATED. "AQUACULTURALLY RAISED OYSTERS" MEANS OYSTERS REARED 18 (2)19 COMMERCIALLY FOR SALE, TRADE, BARTER, OR SHIPMENT. 20 (3)"FEED AND HABITAT" INCLUDES CULTURED ALGAE. THE SALES AND USE TAX DOES NOT APPLY TO A SALE OF THE FOLLOWING 21 **(B)** 22 ITEMS FOR A PURPOSE RELATED TO AQUACULTURALLY RAISED OYSTERS: 23 (1)AQUACULTURALLY RAISED OYSTERS; 24 (2)FEED AND HABITAT; 25 (3)BROOD STOCK;

- 1 (4) FERTILIZER;
- 2 (5) FUNGICIDE, HERBICIDE, OR INSECTICIDE;

3 (6) MATERIALS USED TO CONSTRUCT AQUACULTURE OYSTER FLOATS;

4 AND

5 (7) IF PURCHASED BY A PERSON OR ENTITY ENGAGED IN REARING 6 AQUACULTURALLY RAISED OYSTERS:

7 (I) A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE WITH A 1-TON OR LESS
8 MANUFACTURER'S RATED CAPACITY, USED IN ACTIVITIES RELATING TO
9 AQUACULTURALLY RAISED OYSTERS; AND

(II) ANY EQUIPMENT AND MATERIAL USED TO PREPARE, IRRIGATE,
 11 GROW, SERVICE, HARVEST, STORE, CLEAN, DRY, PACKAGE, OR TRANSPORT
 12 AQUACULTURALLY RAISED OYSTERS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectJuly 1, 2002.

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
