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2 Department of Natural Resources - Vessels

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering certain fees for certain manufacturers' and dealers'
- 4 licenses; altering certain fees relating to the titling and registration of vessels;
- 5 permitting the issuance of a certificate of number and a use sticker for a vessel
- for a certain period for a certain fee; deleting a provision relating to service
- 7 charges for returned checks; and generally relating to fees for vessel titling,
- 8 vessel registration, and vessel dealers and manufacturers.

25 Preamble

- 26 WHEREAS, Maryland has joined with its partner states in the Chesapeake
- 27 Bay watershed through the 2000 Chesapeake Bay Agreement to pledge to take

- 1 actions to restore the Chesapeake Bay by 2010 and has signed an agreement to 2 restore the Coastal Bays; and
- WHEREAS, The Chesapeake Bay Agreement includes a commitment to
- 4 provide every student living in the watershed with a meaningful outdoor Bay
- 5 experience by 2005, and such personal participation has been shown to enhance their
- 6 overall learning experience and to prepare the children, Maryland's future citizens, to
- 7 better appreciate, understand, use, and protect the Chesapeake Bay; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Chesapeake Bay Agreement and the Coastal Bays
- 9 management plan pledge to increase our efforts to protect and restore bay grasses,
- 10 vital habitat of critical importance to our Bays' living resources; and
- WHEREAS, Greater utilization of the Internet and the capabilities of the web
- 12 site of the Department of Natural Resources will enable boat owners to renew their
- 13 boat registrations using this technology resulting in enhanced efficiency and greater
- 14 customer satisfaction among the boating public; and
- WHEREAS, These efforts to protect the Chesapeake Bay and the Coastal Bays
- 16 and increase the Department's utilization of the latest technologies will only move as
- 17 far as funding will permit, and many vessel fees have not increased since the period
- 18 from 1965 to 1970; now, therefore,
- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 21 Article Natural Resources
- 22 8-710.
- 23 (c) (1) Application for a manufacturer's or dealer's license is made on the
- 24 form the Department prescribes and contains the name and address of the applicant.
- 25 If the applicant is a partnership, the application shall include the name and address
- 26 of each partner. If the applicant is a corporation, the application shall contain the
- 27 names of the principal officers of the corporation, the state of incorporation, the
- 28 addresses of every place where the business is conducted, the nature of the business,
- 29 and any other information the Department requires. Every application shall be
- 30 verified by oath or affirmation of the applicant if an individual, or by the partner or
- 31 officer if the applicant is a partnership or corporation. A license fee fixed by the
- 32 Department not to exceed [\$25] \$50 shall accompany every application.
- 33 (2) Registration for purposes of displaying and selling vessels at a boat
- 34 show, boat exposition, or outdoor recreation show shall be made on forms the
- 35 Department prescribes and may require the same information and verification as for
- 36 application for a manufacturer's or dealer's license.
- 37 (3) The registration fee shall be deposited in the Boat Dealer Assurance
- 38 Fund provided for in § 8-710.2 of this subtitle up to the Fund's authorized maximum
- 39 amount. Amounts received in excess of the Fund's authorized maximum amount shall
- 40 be deposited and used in accordance with § 8-723 of this subtitle.

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1 8-712. 2 [Certificates] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH 2 OF THIS (c) (1) 3 SUBSECTION, CERTIFICATES of number issued under this section shall be valid for a 4 period not to exceed 2 years. The owner of the vessel may apply every other year for 5 renewal of the certificate. The renewed certificate shall expire on December 31 of the 6 calendar year following the year the certificate is issued. The fee for a 2-year 7 certificate for vessels is [\$24] \$40. [Vessels] THE FEE FOR VESSELS 16 feet in length 8 or less and equipped with a 7 1/2 horsepower motor or less [are exempt from this fee] 9 IS \$25. 10 A CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER ISSUED UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL (2) 11 BE VALID FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 3 YEARS. THE OWNER OF THE VESSEL MAY 12 APPLY EVERY THIRD YEAR FOR RENEWAL OF THE CERTIFICATE. THE RENEWED 13 CERTIFICATE SHALL EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31 OF THE SECOND CALENDAR YEAR 14 FOLLOWING THE YEAR THE CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED. THE FEE FOR A 3-YEAR 15 CERTIFICATE FOR VESSELS IS \$60. THE FEE FOR VESSELS 16 FEET IN LENGTH OR 16 LESS EQUIPPED WITH A 7 1/2 HORSEPOWER MOTOR OR LESS IS \$37.50. 17 The fee to replace a lost, destroyed, or corrected certificate is [\$2]\$10. 18 The Department shall record any transaction or transfer of numbered boats. The 19 Department may record any amount of money owing on a vessel required to be 20 numbered at the time of sale. The Department may not effect a transfer of ownership 21 until the amount of money owed as shown on the records of the Department is fully 22 paid or recorded on the new title. Any vessel that is required to be numbered under 23 this section that is exempt prior to January 1, 1974 shall be exempt from payment of 24 this title tax. 25 [(2)]Emergency rescue boats that belong to fire departments or (4) 26 rescue squads in Maryland: 27 (i) Shall be exempt from all registration fees; but 28 (ii) Shall apply for a registration renewal every 3 years. 29 [(f) There is a \$5 service charge for every check returned unpaid.] 30 8-712.1. 31 An owner of a vessel that has a valid document issued by the United (a) (1) 32 States Coast Guard and that is used principally on the waters of the State for 33 pleasure shall apply to the Department for a Maryland use sticker. 34 The Department shall issue a Maryland use sticker to any person 35 who submits an application and pays [a fee as required by subsection (b) of this 36 section] THE REQUISITE FEE.

[The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS

38 SUBSECTION, THE Maryland use sticker issued under this section shall be valid for a

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- 1 period not to exceed 2 years expiring on December 31 of the calendar year following
- 2 the year the sticker is issued.
- 3 (4) A MARYLAND USE STICKER ISSUED UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL
- 4 BE VALID FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 3 YEARS. THE OWNER OF THE VESSEL MAY
- 5 APPLY EVERY THIRD YEAR FOR RENEWAL OF THE USE STICKER. THE RENEWED USE
- 6 STICKER SHALL EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31 OF THE SECOND CALENDAR YEAR
- 7 FOLLOWING THE YEAR THE USE STICKER IS ISSUED. THE FEE FOR A 3-YEAR USE
- 8 STICKER FOR VESSELS IS \$60.
- 9 (b) The owner of the vessel shall:
- 10 (1) Submit an application to the Department on the form that the
- 11 Department requires and be signed by every owner of the vessel; and
- 12 (2) Pay to the Department an application fee of [\$10] \$40 for the 2-year
- 13 sticker.
- 14 8-714.
- 15 (c) Each application for the manufacturer's or dealer's certificates of number
- 16 shall be on forms the Department approves and be accompanied by a fee of [\$24] \$40.
- 17 The certificate of number issued under this section is valid for a period not to exceed
- 18 2 years and shall expire on December 31 of the calendar year following the year the
- 19 certificate is issued.

- 21 (b) The Department shall charge a [\$2] \$10 fee to issue a certificate of title, a
- 22 transfer of title, or a duplicate or corrected certificate of title.
- 23 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 8-712(g) and (h),
- 24 respectively, of Article Natural Resources of the Annotated Code of Maryland be
- 25 renumbered to be Section(s) 8-712(f) and (g), respectively.
- 26 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 27 effect October 1, 2002.
