- 5 A COUNTY MAY ADOPT PROVISIONS CONCERNING CAMPAIGN FINANCE, ONLY IF 6 THE PROVISIONS ARE:
- 7 (1) AT LEAST AS STRINGENT AS THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE; AND
- 8 (2) NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE.
- 9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall
- 10 take effect October 1, 2002. It shall remain effective until the taking effect of Section
- 11 2 of this Act. If Section 2 of this Act takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be
- 12 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
- 13 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions
- 14 of Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect January 1, 2003.
