A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Motor Fuel - Raising Price During State of Emergency Prohibited

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a retail service station dealer from raising the price of
- 4 motor fuel sold at the retail service station during a state of emergency declared
- by the Governor; requiring the Comptroller to conduct a certain investigation
- 6 within a certain period of time on receipt of a certain complaint; establishing
- 7 certain penalties for a violation of this Act; and generally relating to prohibiting
- 8 retail service station dealers from raising the price of motor fuel during a state
- 9 of emergency.

- 25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 26 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Regulation

- 3 (A) DURING A STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARED BY THE GOVERNOR, A
- 4 RETAIL SERVICE STATION DEALER MAY NOT RAISE THE PRICE OF MOTOR FUEL SOLD
- 5 AT THE RETAIL SERVICE STATION.
- 6 (B) IF THE COMPTROLLER RECEIVES A COMPLAINT IN WRITING THAT A
- 7 RETAIL SERVICE STATION DEALER HAS RAISED THE PRICE OF MOTOR FUEL DURING
- 8 A STATE OF EMERGENCY, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL INVESTIGATE AND DETERMINE
- 9 WITHIN 3 BUSINESS DAYS OF THE RECEIPT OF THE COMPLAINT WHETHER THE
- 10 ALLEGATIONS CONTAINED IN THE COMPLAINT ARE TRUE.
- 11 (C) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ISSUE A STOP SALE NOTICE AND MAY
- 12 SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION OF A RETAIL SERVICE
- 13 STATION DEALER IF THE COMPTROLLER DETERMINES THAT THE RETAIL SERVICE
- 14 STATION DEALER IS IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.

- 16 The Comptroller shall issue a stop sale notice if the Comptroller finds that a
- 17 person
- 18 (1) stores or sells motor fuel from a location that does not have a valid
- 19 certificate of registration;
- 20 (2) willfully uses a motor fuel advertisement that is misleading;
- 21 (3) willfully markets motor fuel that has not been approved; [or]
- 22 (4) sells motor fuel below cost in violation of § 10-304.1 of this subtitle;
- 23 OR
- 24 (5) RAISES THE PRICE OF MOTOR FUEL IN VIOLATION OF § 10-304.2 OF
- 25 THIS SUBTITLE.
- 26 10-324.
- 27 Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, a person who violates this subtitle
- 28 or aids or assists in the violation of this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on
- 29 conviction, is subject to a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 1
- 30 year or both.
- 31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 32 October 1, 2002.
