- 1 AN ACT concerning
- 2 Uniformed State Employees
- 3 FOR the purpose of allowing certain State employees to attach, in an appropriate
- 4 manner, a patch of the United States flag on their uniforms; and generally
- 5 relating to the uniforms of uniformed State employees.
- 6 BY adding to
- 7 Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 8 Section 2-308
- 9 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 10 (1997 Replacement Volume and 2001 Supplement)
- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 14 2-308.
- 15 (A) A UNIFORMED STATE EMPLOYEE MAY ATTACH, IN AN APPROPRIATE
- 16 MANNER, A PATCH OF THE UNITED STATES FLAG TO THE EMPLOYEE'S UNIFORM.
- 17 (B) NOTHING IN THIS ARTICLE OR CORRESPONDING REGULATIONS MAY BE
- 18 CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT A UNIFORMED STATE EMPLOYEE FROM ATTACHING A
- 19 PATCH OF THE UNITED STATES FLAG TO THE EMPLOYEE'S UNIFORM.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 21 October 1, 2002.
