A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Uniformed State Employees**

3 FOR the purpose of allowing certain State employees to attach, in an appropriate
4 manner, a patch of the United States flag on their uniforms; and generally
5 relating to the uniforms of uniformed State employees.

7 Article - State Personnel and Pensions
8 Section 2-308
9 Annotated Code of Maryland
10 (1997 Replacement Volume and 2001 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

14 2-308.

15 (A) A UNIFORMED STATE EMPLOYEE MAY ATTACH, IN AN APPROPRIATE
16 MANNER, A PATCH OF THE UNITED STATES FLAG TO THE EMPLOYEE'S UNIFORM.

17 (B) NOTHING IN THIS ARTICLE OR CORRESPONDING REGULATIONS MAY BE
18 CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT A UNIFORMED STATE EMPLOYEE FROM ATTACHING A
19 PATCH OF THE UNITED STATES FLAG TO THE EMPLOYEE'S UNIFORM.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2002.
