 SERVICE ON THE BOARD UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
 (2) The terms of the ELECTED trustees are staggered as required by the
 terms of the ELECTED trustees serving on July 1, 1988.
 (3) (I) [A] AN ELECTED trustee serves only for the remainder of a
 term if the trustee is ELECTED [appointed:

(i) To] TO fill a vacancy in an unexpired [term; or

9 (ii) To succeed a trustee who is holding over] TERM.

(II) AN ELECTED TRUSTEE SERVING IN ACCORDANCE WITH
 SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH IS ELIGIBLE TO SERVE ONE CONSECUTIVE
 TERM AFTER THE EXPIRATION OF THE TERM THE TRUSTEE FILLED DUE TO
 VACANCY.

19 [(e)] (D) On taking office, each ELECTED trustee shall take the oath required 20 by Article I, § 9 of the Maryland Constitution.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 2002.
