3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of County Commissioners of Carroll
4 County to dispose of certain surplus supplies, equipment, or other personal
5 property valued less than a certain amount in a certain manner; and generally
6 relating to the disposition of public property in Carroll County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 25 - County Commissioners**

15 11A.

16 (G) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, IN CARROLL
17 COUNTY, PROVIDED THAT THE SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT, OR OTHER PERSONAL
18 PROPERTY ARE VALUED AT LESS THAN \$100, THE BOARD OF COUNTY
19 COMMISSIONERS OF CARROLL COUNTY MAY DISPOSE OF SURPLUS SUPPLIES,
20 EQUIPMENT, OR OTHER PERSONAL PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE COUNTY BY THE
21 FOLLOWING MEANS:

22 (1) PUBLIC AUCTION;

23 (2) PUBLIC SALE, PROVIDED THAT THE SALE IS ADVERTISED THROUGH
24 A PRESS RELEASE OR PUBLIC NOTICE IN A MEDIA ACCESSIBLE TO THE GENERAL
25 PUBLIC;

26 (3) TRANSFER TO A STATE, MUNICIPAL, OR COUNTY GOVERNMENT
27 AGENCY;

1 (4) TRANSFER TO A PRIVATE NONPROFIT CORPORATION THAT IS
2 AUTHORIZED TO RECEIVE APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE COUNTY, PROVIDED THAT
3 THE PRIVATE NONPROFIT CORPORATION IS AN EXEMPT ORGANIZATION AS DEFINED
4 IN § 501(C)(3) OF TITLE 26 OF THE UNITED STATES CODE;

5 (5) DEPOSIT AT THE SWAP SHOT AT THE NORTHERN LANDFILL; OR

6 (6) DISPOSAL IN A SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITY.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2002.
