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## A BILL ENTITLED

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## 2 Advisory Commission on Transportation Options for Senior Citizens

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing an Advisory Commission on Transportation Options
- 4 for Senior Citizens; specifying the membership of the Advisory Commission;
- 5 requiring the Governor to designate a chairman; requiring the Advisory
- 6 Commission to undertake a certain study and develop certain legislative
- 7 initiatives; requiring the Advisory Commission to report to the Governor and the
- 8 General Assembly before a certain date; providing for the termination of this
- 9 Act; and generally relating to an Advisory Commission on Transportation
- 10 Options for Senior Citizens.
- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That:
- 13 (a) There is an Advisory Commission on Transportation Options for Senior
- 14 Citizens.
- 15 (b) The Advisory Commission consists of the following members:
- 16 (1) One member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President
- 17 of the Senate;
- 18 (2) One member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of
- 19 the House;
- 20 (3) The Secretary of Transportation or the Secretary's designee;
- 21 (4) The State Highway Administrator or the Administrator's designee;
- 22 (5) The Motor Vehicle Administrator or the Administrator's designee;
- 23 and
- 24 (6) A representative of the United Seniors of Maryland, appointed by the
- 25 Governor.
- 26 (c) The Governor shall designate the chairman of the Advisory Commission.

- 1 (d) The Department of Transportation shall provide staff for the Advisory 2 Commission.
- 3 (e) The Advisory Commission shall:
- 4 (1) Examine the unique transportation needs of senior citizens in the
- 5 State.
- 6 (2) Identify access, mobility, and safety issues important to senior 7 citizens in the State.
- 8 (3) Identify transportation challenges confronting senior citizens in the 9 State.
- 10 (4) Develop legislative initiatives to improve the availability and quality 11 of transportation for senior citizens in the State.
- 12 (f) The Advisory Commission shall report its findings and recommendations
- 13 to the Governor and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General
- 14 Assembly on or before December 1, 2002.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 June 1, 2002. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of May 31,
- 17 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
- 18 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
