17	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall take effect October 1, 2002. It shall remain effective until the taking effect of Section 2 of this Act. If Section 2 of this Act takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
19 20	SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions of Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect January 1, 2003.
21	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
24 25 26	(a) The provisions of Section 1 and Section 2 of this Act are contingent on the Legislative Districting Plan of 2002 that took effect on February 22, 2002 remaining unchanged with respect to the legislative districts lying in whole or in part in Baltimore County as a result of an order issued by a court in any lawsuit filed challenging the constitutionality or legality of the Legislative Districting Plan of 2002.
30 31	(b) If a ruling by a court in a lawsuit described in subsection (a) of this Section results in changes to the Legislative Districting Plan of 2002 with respect to the legislative districts lying in whole or in part in Baltimore County, then Sections 1 and 2 of this Act are null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.
33	SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That if, by June 30, 2002, a

34 court has issued an order that alters the Legislative Districting Plan of 2002 with 35 respect to legislative districts lying in whole or in part in Baltimore County, then the 36 Baltimore County Democratic Party Central Committee shall consist of five members

37 elected from each councilmanic district in Baltimore County.

- SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions 1
- 2 of Sections 3 and 4 of this Act, Section 2 of this Act shall take effect January 1, 2003,
- 3 contingent on the taking effect of Chapter ___ (S.B. 1) of the Acts of the General
- 4 Assembly of 2002. If Section 2 of this Act takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be
- 5 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
- 6 SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions 7 of Sections 3, 4, and 5 of this Act, this Act shall take effect July 1, 2002.
