- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Natural Resources
- 14 5-906.
- 15 (b) Every acquisition and development project funded by the State in whole or
- 16 in part shall meet needs identified in the Maryland Land Preservation and
- 17 Recreation Plan prepared and revised every [5] 6 years, beginning in 1993, by the
- 18 Department of Planning in cooperation with the Department. The document shall
- 19 identify and recommend for State acquisition efforts those resource areas facing the
- 20 most intense or immediate development pressure. These resource areas shall be
- 21 designated as targeted areas. The document and any changes to it shall be distributed
- 22 to every local governing body.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 October 1, 2002.
