- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

In Charles and Kent counties the County Commissioners 25 also shall have the authority to make special provisions for retirement funds for

 25 also shall have the authority to make special provisions for retirement funds for
 26 employees who reach retirement age prior to the origination of a retirement system.
 27 In Dorchester County the County Commissioners may include the employees of the
 28 Dorchester County liquor control board and the Dorchester County Sheriff's
 29 department in any pensions, retirement or group insurance program established and
 30 maintained by the county. In Kent County the County Commissioners may include
 31 any official or employee of the Kent County Sheriff's department in any pension,
 32 retirement or group insurance program established and maintained by Kent County.
- 33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 34 July 1, 2002.
