7 <u>(V)</u> <u>1 SHALL BE A VETERAN OF THE PERSIAN GULF WAR APPOINTED</u> 8 <u>FROM THE STATE AT LARGE.</u>

9 (b) Each member must be a resident of the State and a veteran whose final 10 separation from active service with a uniformed service of the United States was 11 under honorable conditions.

12 (c) (1) The term of an appointed member is 7 years.

13 (2) The terms of the appointed members are staggered as required by the 14 terms provided for members of the Commission on October 1, 1984.

15 (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is 16 appointed and qualifies.

17 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for 18 the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2002.
