- 1 (b) Each member must be a resident of the State and a veteran whose final 2 separation from active service with a uniformed service of the United States was 3 under honorable conditions.
- 4 (c) (1) The term of an appointed member is 7 years.
- 5 (2) The terms of the appointed members are staggered as required by the 6 terms provided for members of the Commission on October 1, 1984.
- 7 (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is 8 appointed and qualifies.
- 9 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for 10 the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2002.
