15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 (g) "Expressway" means a major highway of 2 or more traffic lanes in each 20 direction that is designed to eliminate principal traffic hazards and has the following 21 characteristics:

(1) A median divider separating opposing traffic lanes to eliminatehead-on collisions and sideswiping;

24 (2) Grade separation structures to eliminate the conflict of cross streams 25 of traffic at each intersection;

26 (3) Points of entrance and exit limited to predetermined locations;
