A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Health - Managed Care Organizations - Credentialing**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a managed care organization to deem a health care
4 provider credentialed for a certain period of time under certain circumstances
5 and upon certain verification; prohibiting a certain entity from refusing to
6 provide certain information to a managed care organization; providing that this
7 Act does not relieve a managed care organization of certain obligations; and
8 generally relating to the credentialing of a health care provider by a managed
9 care organization.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - Health - General**

18 15-103.4.

19 (A) A MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION MAY DEEM A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER
20 CREDENTIALLED FOR A PERIOD OF NOT MORE THAN 6 MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF
21 RECEIPT OF A COMPLETED APPLICATION IF:

22 (1) THE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER:

23 (I) HAS BEEN CREDENTIALLED BY ANOTHER ENTITY IN THE STATE
24 THAT IS REQUIRED TO CREDENTIAL HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS; AND

25 (II) HAS SUBMITTED AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
26 MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION'S PROVIDER PANEL; AND

1 (2) THE MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION VERIFIES THAT THE HEALTH
2 CARE PROVIDER WAS CREDENTIALLED AND REMAINS IN GOOD STANDING WITH AT
3 LEAST ONE ENTITY THAT CREDENTIALLED THE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER.

4 (B) AN ENTITY THAT HAS CREDENTIALLED A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER MAY
5 NOT REFUSE TO PROVIDE INFORMATION TO A MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION THAT
6 SEEKS VERIFICATION OF THE CREDENTIALLED HEALTH CARE PROVIDER.

7 (C) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION MAY BE CONSTRUED TO RELIEVE THE
8 MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION FROM FULLY CREDENTIALING ITS HEALTH CARE
9 PROVIDERS.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2002.
