- 10 WHEREAS, Farming is an important part of Maryland's economy; and
- WHEREAS, The ability of Maryland farmers to provide a stable, local supply of
- 12 farm products is of great importance to the health and welfare of the State; and
- WHEREAS, By preserving open spaces, sculpting the landscape, and providing
- 14 a land base for many recreational activities, farms are essential for maintaining the
- 15 State's rural communities and character; and
- WHEREAS, Apples and large amounts of cereal grass, from which oatmeal is
- 17 made, are grown in Maryland; now, therefore,
- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
