## 2 Cecil County - Commissioners - Authority to Set Salaries of Successors

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Cecil County Commissioners to raise the salaries
- 4 of the County Commissioners of Cecil County by ordinance provided that the
- 5 altered salaries may not take effect until the next following term of office after
- 6 the adoption of the ordinance; and generally relating to the alteration of the
- 7 salaries of the Cecil County Commissioners.

- 11 Article 8 Public Local Laws of Maryland

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article 8 Cecil County

16 15-4.

- 17 A. Each member of the Board of County Commissioners shall receive a salary 18 of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.) per year.
- 19 B. In addition, each member of the Board of County Commissioners of Cecil
- 20 County shall receive the benefits and reimbursements for reasonable expenses in the
- 21 performance of duties as provided in the Cecil County budget or by law, including,
- 22 where appropriate:
- 23 (1) Reimbursements under the standard state travel regulations; and
- 24 (2) Participation in the health care plan that is negotiated for county

25 employees.

- 1 C. They shall receive two thousand dollars (\$2,000.) per year to cover
- 2 expenses, except that the President of the Board shall receive an additional five
- 3 hundred dollars (\$500.).
- 4 D. In addition, for all mileage expenses and other expenses related to county
- 5 business, each Commissioner shall submit a voucher to the County Treasurer for
- 6 reimbursement.
- 7 E. NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION A. OF THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY
- 8 COMMISSIONERS OF CECIL COUNTY MAY, BY ORDINANCE, RAISE THE SALARIES OF
- 9 THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CECIL COUNTY IF THE ALTERATION IN SALARIES
- 10 DOES NOT TAKE EFFECT UNTIL THE NEXT FOLLOWING TERM OF OFFICE AFTER THE
- 11 ADOPTION OF THE ORDINANCE.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 13 effect October 1, 2002.
