- and Girls' Homes Loan of 2001, that the grantee grant and convey a certain 5

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 14 Chapter 293 of the Acts of 2001

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That:
- 17 [(6)]Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey (a)
- 18 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of
- 19 its interest:
- 20 On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust; (i)
- 21 and
- 22 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
- 23 structures.
- 24 If the grantee or beneficiary of the grant holds a lease on the land
- 25 and structures, the Trust may accept an easement on the leasehold interest.

- 1 (c) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust 2 and any liens or encumbrances against the land or the structures must be acceptable 3 to the Trust.]
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 5 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
- 6 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members 7 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 8 the date it is enacted.
