- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 9-2006.
- 19 (A) A PERSON MAY APPLY TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOR A HOME ENERGY
- 20 RATING CERTIFICATE PROVIDING A STANDARDIZED EVALUATION OF A HOME'S
- 21 ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND EXPECTED ENERGY COSTS.
- 22 (B) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:
- 23 (1) PROVIDE A HOME ENERGY RATING CERTIFICATE TO AN APPLICANT
- 24 WHO SUBMITS EVIDENCE OF A HOME ENERGY RATING FROM A QUALIFIED
- 25 PROVIDER;
- 26 (2) ESTABLISH GUIDELINES WHICH A PROVIDER MAY FOLLOW TO
- 27 PRODUCE UNIFORM HOME ENERGY RATINGS; AND

- 1 (3) ESTABLISH STANDARDS FOR QUALIFYING HOME ENERGY RATING
- 2 PROVIDERS.
- 3 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY CHARGE A REASONABLE FEE TO ANY
- 4 APPLICANT FOR A HOME ENERGY RATING CERTIFICATE AS PROVIDED IN THIS
- 5 SECTION.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 7 January 1, 2003.
