- 17 FOR PURPOSES OF 18 U.S.C. § 921(A)(20), A PERSON'S CIVIL RIGHTS SHALL BE
- 18 DEEMED RESTORED IF THE PERSON WAS CONVICTED OF A COMMON LAW
- 19 MISDEMEANOR AND SENTENCED TO SERVE A TERM OF CONFINEMENT, NOT
- 20 INCLUDING THE SUSPENDED PORTION OF A SENTENCE, OF:
- 21 (1) 30 DAYS OR FEWER; OR
- 22 (2) MORE THAN 30 DAYS AND FEWER THAN 6 MONTHS IF MORE THAN 10
- 23 YEARS HAVE PASSED SINCE THE EXPIRATION OF THE SENTENCE, INCLUDING ANY
- 24 TERM OF PAROLE OR PROBATION.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 July 1, 2002.
