SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

- 10 (a) shall review the compensation of District Court bailiffs and evaluate

- 14 in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on its findings and

- 17 of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act,
- 18 shall apply to all bailiffs employed by the District Court on or after the effective date
- 19 of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 4: 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 21 effect October 1, 2002.
