(1)subsection, five (5) County Commissioners shall be elected at-large in the general 17 election to be held in November, 2002. 18 19 In an at-large election for a specific County Commissioner position (2)20 as provided in this section, the candidate who is a resident of that Commissioner 21 District and who receives the highest number of votes in the at-large election shall be 22 elected. 23 (3)Two (2) County Commissioners elected at-large in the general 24 election to be held in November, 2002, and who reside in Commissioner Districts 1 25 and [2] 5, shall each hold office for a term of two years. 26 The County Commissioner positions under Paragraph (3) of this (4)27 section shall be elected at-large in the general election to be held in November 2004 28 subject to the requirements of Paragraph (2) of this subsection, and shall each hold 29 office for a term of four years and shall be elected every successive four years 30 thereafter. 31 Three (3) County Commissioners elected at-large in the general (5)32 election to be held in November 2002, and who reside in Commissioner Districts [3, 4, 33 and 5, 2, 3, AND 4, shall each hold office for a term of four years and shall be elected 34 every successive four years thereafter.

35 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 36 effect October June 1, 2002.
