- 3 FOR the purpose of altering Commissioner Districts for the Board of County
- Commissioners for Cecil County; altering the districts from which the
- Commissioners are to be elected to a 2-year term in the election held in 5
- November, 2002, and to 4-year terms thereafter; altering the districts from 6
- which the Commissioners are to be elected to 4-year terms in November, 2002 7
- 8 and thereafter; and generally relating to the Board of County Commissioners for
- 9 Cecil County.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 The Board of County Commissioners of Cecil County shall be elected by the
- 20 voters of the county at large and hold office in accordance with the following
- 21 provisions:

		[(2) Following the decennial census of the United States in 2000, there be established a Commissioner District Committee to issue recommendations on boundaries of five Commissioner Districts to the General Assembly.						
7 8	(3) The Commissioner District Committee shall consist of seven (7) members, with three (3) members appointed by the County Democratic Central Committee, three (3) members appointed by the County Republican Central Committee, and one (1) member who shall be appointed by the County Board of Supervisors of Elections.							
10 11	(4) The members of the Commissioner District Committee shall elect one of the members as Chairman of the Commissioner District Committee.

- 1 THAT PART OF CECIL COUNTY ELECTION DISTRICT 5, PRECINCT (C) 2 2 THAT CONSISTS OF CENSUS TRACT 309.01, BLOCKS 1008, 1009, 1014, 1015, 1017 3 THROUGH 1024, 2009 THROUGH 2016, 2018, 2031 THROUGH 2034, AND 5000 THROUGH 4 5137. 5 B. One (1) Commissioner shall be elected from each Commissioner District. 6 A person may not be eligible as a candidate for County Commissioner C. 7 unless he is a resident of the Commissioner District at the time of nomination and 8 election. 9 D. Subject to the provisions of Paragraphs (2) through (5) of this (1) 10 subsection, five (5) County Commissioners shall be elected at-large in the general election to be held in November, 2002. 12 (2) In an at-large election for a specific County Commissioner position 13 as provided in this section, the candidate who is a resident of that Commissioner 14 District and who receives the highest number of votes in the at-large election shall be 15 elected. 16 Two (2) County Commissioners elected at-large in the general 17 election to be held in November, 2002, and who reside in Commissioner Districts 1 18 and [2] 5, shall each hold office for a term of two years. 19 The County Commissioner positions under Paragraph (3) of this (4) 20 section shall be elected at-large in the general election to be held in November 2004 21 subject to the requirements of Paragraph (2) of this subsection, and shall each hold 22 office for a term of four years and shall be elected every successive four years 23 thereafter. 24 (5) Three (3) County Commissioners elected at-large in the general 25 election to be held in November 2002, and who reside in Commissioner Districts [3, 4, 26 and 5, 12, 3, AND 4, shall each hold office for a term of four years and shall be elected
- 27 every successive four years thereafter.
- 28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 29 effect October 1, 2002.
