3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a lawyer from offering or discussing certain offers of

5 offers of employment to judges by lawyers.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions**

14 10-605.3.

15 A LAWYER MAY NOT, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, OFFER EMPLOYMENT TO OR
16 DISCUSS OPPORTUNITIES FOR EMPLOYMENT BY THE LAWYER, OR BY A LAW FIRM
17 WITH WHICH THE LAWYER IS ASSOCIATED, WITH ANY JUDGE OF A COURT IF THE
18 JUDGE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED TO, OR IS CURRENTLY PRESIDING OVER, ANY CASE IN
19 WHICH THE LAWYER OR A LAW FIRM WITH WHICH THE LAWYER IS ASSOCIATED HAS
20 ENTERED AN APPEARANCE OR HAS A FINANCIAL INTEREST.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2002.
