

- 18 (a) This section does not apply to a transfer of service credit to or from the

- 21 (b) (1) An individual may not transfer service credit under this title unless
- 22 the individual makes a claim for the service credit within 1 year after becoming a
- 23 member of the new system.
- 24 (2) An individual may not transfer service credit from one contributory
- 25 system to another contributory system unless within 1 year after becoming a member
- 26 of the new system the individual deposits in the annuity savings fund or other
- 27 corresponding fund of the new system the total accumulated contributions to the

- 1 (2) submits a completed claim form to the State Retirement Agency and
- 2 deposits in the annuity savings fund of the State Police Retirement System the

- 4 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 5 construed retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect only
- 6 individuals who became members of the State Police Retirement System on or after
- 7 January 1, 2000.
- 8 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 July 1, 2002. It shall remain effective for a period of 12 months and, at the end of June
- 10 30, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
- 11 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
