- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the court to appoint a guardian ad litem in certain
- 4 custody or visitation proceedings; requiring the guardian ad litem to hold a
- 5 certain license and have experience in certain areas; requiring the guardian ad
- 6 litem to attend certain training; providing that the court must inform the
- 7 guardian ad litem of certain procedures; establishing the duties of the guardian
- 8 ad litem; defining a certain term; and generally relating to a guardian ad litem

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "GUARDIAN AD LITEM" MEANS AN ATTORNEY, SOCIAL
- 20 WORKER, OR PSYCHOLOGIST APPOINTED BY THE COURT TO REPRESENT THE BEST
- 21 INTEREST OF THE CHILD IN CUSTODY OR VISITATION PROCEEDINGS UNDER THIS
- 22 TITLE.
- 23 (B) THE COURT MAY APPOINT A GUARDIAN AD LITEM FOR A CHILD IN A
- 24 CONTESTED CUSTODY OR VISITATION PROCEEDING IF THE COURT CANNOT
- 25 DETERMINE WHAT IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CHILD BASED SOLELY ON THE
- 26 EVIDENCE AND TESTIMONY PRESENTED DURING A PROCEEDING.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2002.
