A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Environment - Lead Paint Risk Reduction - Inspections**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the frequency at which an owner of certain property
4 must have the property inspected to verify that certain lead paint risk reduction
5 standards have been satisfied; and generally relating to inspections verifying
6 the satisfaction of lead paint risk reduction standards.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Environment**

15 6-815.

16 (c) Except for affected properties that pass a test for lead-contaminated dust
17 under § 6-816 of this subtitle, EVERY 2 YEARS OR at each change in occupancy,
18 WHICHEVER OCCURS LATER, an owner of an affected property shall have the property
19 inspected to verify that the risk reduction standard specified in this section has been
20 satisfied.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2002.
