## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A House Joint Resolution concerning

2 Clean Air Act

- 3 FOR the purpose of urging the United States Congress to reject legislation that would
- 4 weaken the Clean Air Act; directing that copies of this resolution be forwarded to
- 5 certain persons; and generally relating to the Clean Air Act.
- 6 WHEREAS, The Honorable George W. Bush, President of the United States, is
- 7 anticipated to support legislation that will weaken the Clean Air Act and allow
- 8 coal-burning power plants to bypass antipollution laws and regulations; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The State has shown dedication and commitment to enforcing the
- 10 provisions of the Clean Air Act in order to improve the air quality of the State; and
- WHEREAS, The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the State of Maryland,
- 12 and several other eastern states filed suit against dozens of power plants located in
- 13 the Midwest for failing to install tighter pollution controls as required by current law;
- 14 and
- WHEREAS, Weakening the Clean Air Act will have a detrimental affect on air
- 16 quality and the environment of the State; now, therefore, be it
- 17 RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the United
- 18 States Congress is urged to reject any legislation that will weaken the current
- 19 provisions of the Clean Air Act and encouraged to continue to support legislation that
- 20 will strengthen existing laws affecting air quality; and be it further
