#### **Circuit Court Clerks - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the maximum salary that the Board of Public Works may

- 4 set for a clerk of a circuit court; repealing the minimum salaries for the clerks of
- 5 the circuit courts; and providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or
- 6 compensation of an incumbent clerk.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

# 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

15 2-504.

16 (a) The clerk of each circuit court shall receive an annual salary of not [less 17 than \$10,000 or] more than [\$75,000] \$85,000 as set by the Board of Public Works on 18 the basis of the relative volume of business and receipts in [his] THE CLERK'S office.

19 [In Baltimore City, the clerk's salary may not be less than \$12,000.]

20 (b) A clerk shall devote his full working time to the duties of [his] THE 21 CLERK'S office and is entitled to the salary prescribed in subsection (a).

1 (c) The salary of a clerk is payable biweekly.

2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,

3 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or 4 apply to the salary or compensation of the clerk of each circuit court in office on the

5 effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or

6 compensation of the clerk of each circuit court shall take effect at the beginning of the 7 next following term of office.

8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2002.
