

- 4 FOR the purpose of creating the consolidated senior veterans' sport fishing license;

- 3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 4 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 7 (A) (1) THERE IS A CONSOLIDATED SENIOR VETERANS' SPORT FISHING 8 LICENSE.
- 9 (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE A CONSOLIDATED SENIOR VETERANS'
- 10 SPORT FISHING LICENSE TO A RESIDENT OR NONRESIDENT VETERAN, AS DEFINED
- 11 UNDER § 9-901 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, BEGINNING IN THE CALENDAR
- 12 YEAR IN WHICH THE VETERAN ATTAINS THE AGE OF 70 YEARS.
- 13 (3) THERE IS NO FEE FOR THE CONSOLIDATED SENIOR VETERANS' 14 SPORT FISHING LICENSE.
- 15 (B) A HOLDER OF A CONSOLIDATED SENIOR VETERANS' SPORT FISHING 16 LICENSE MAY:
- 17 (1) ENGAGE IN ANGLING ON THE NONTIDAL WATERS OF THE STATE
- 18 WITHOUT HOLDING AN ANGLER'S LICENSE UNDER § 4-604 OF THIS TITLE;
- 19 (2) ENGAGE IN ANGLING FOR TROUT ON THE NONTIDAL WATERS OF
- 20 THE STATE WITHOUT HOLDING A TROUT STAMP UNDER § 4-614 OF THIS TITLE; AND
- 21 (3) FISH FOR FINFISH IN THE CHESAPEAKE BAY AND ITS TRIBUTARIES

- 24 (C) A CONSOLIDATED SENIOR VETERANS' SPORT FISHING LICENSE:
- 25 (1) IS VALID FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR; AND
- 26 (2) EXPIRES ON DECEMBER 31 OF THE YEAR OF ISSUANCE.

The trout stamps 5 may be furnished to agents upon consignment if the Department is given adequate 6 security to insure ultimate payment to the Department for the stamps. 7 4-745. 8 (a) (1)Except as provided in subsections (c) and (d) of this section, a person 9 may not fish for finfish in the Chesapeake Bay or in its tributaries up to tidal 10 boundaries without first obtaining a Chesapeake Bay sport fishing license. 11 (c) A person may fish for finfish in the Chesapeake Bay or its tidal tributaries without a Chesapeake Bay sport fishing license if the person: 13 (1) Is under the age of 16; 14 Possesses a valid commercial license: (2) 15 Is fishing from private real property as an owner, family member of (3) 16 an owner, or nonpaying guest of an owner; 17 Is fishing with a hook and line from a public bridge or public pier 18 which has been designated by the Department as a free fishing area; 19 Holds a valid tidal water sport fishing license issued by the State of 20 Virginia, Potomac River Fisheries Commission, or District of Columbia, provided that 21 this exemption shall not take effect until the Secretary has published notice in the 22 Maryland Register of the Secretary's determination that the Virginia, Potomac River 23 Fisheries Commission, or District of Columbia requirements for a tidal water sport 24 fishing license are substantially similar to and reciprocal with the Chesapeake Bay 25 sport fishing license requirements of this section; Is fishing pursuant to any special license issued under subsection (d) 26 (6)27 of this section; Is on active duty with the armed forces of the United States; 28 (7)(i) 29 (ii) Is a resident of this State; 30 (iii) Is on leave from the armed forces; and 31 (iv) Has, while fishing, a copy of the person's official leave orders; 32 Fishes on a free fishing day designated by the Secretary; [or] (8)

Holds a current resident consolidated senior sport fishing license

- 1 (10) HOLDS A CURRENT CONSOLIDATED SENIOR VETERANS' SPORT 2 FISHING LICENSE ISSUED UNDER § 4-217 OF THIS TITLE.
