(3) Transfers from the Trust Fund under paragraph (2) of this subsection
 may be made only in accordance with an appropriation approved by the General
 Assembly in the annual State budget.

4 (f) (1) The State Treasurer shall hold the Trust Fund and the Comptroller 5 shall account for the Trust Fund.

6 (2) The Trust Fund shall be invested and reinvested in the same manner 7 as other State funds and any investment earnings of the Trust Fund shall be paid into 8 the Trust Fund.

9 (3) The State Treasurer shall deposit funds into the two accounts of the 10 Trust Fund in the manner described in subsection (d) of this section.

11 (g) (1) The Trust Fund is a continuing, nonlapsing fund and is not subject to 12 § 7-302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

13(2)No part of the Trust Fund may revert or be credited to the General14Fund of the State.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2002.
