3 **Plate Program - Extension**

5 Commemorative License Plate Program until a certain date; and generally
6 relating to the Chesapeake Bay Commemorative License Plate Program.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article - Transportation**

22 13-618.

23 (c) (1) An original or substitute commemorative plate may only be issued
24 under this section for a fixed period of 2 consecutive years after its initial issuance.

25 (2) The Administration may only issue 1 commemorative plate under
26 this section at any one time.

2 **Chapter 91 of the Acts of 1994, Chapter 356 of the Acts of 1996, Chapter 141 of**
3 **the Acts of 1998, and Chapter 340 of the Acts of 2000**

4 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding the
5 provisions of § 13-618(c) of the Transportation Article, the Motor Vehicle
6 Administration shall extend the Chesapeake Bay Commemorative Plate Program
7 until July 1, [2002] 2008.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 June 1, 2002.
