1 2	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 2 construed to apply retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect the
- 3 estates of all decedents who died as a result of wounds or injury incurred as a result
- 4 of the terrorist attacks against the United States on September 11, 2001.
- 5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 6 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
- 7 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
- 8 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 9 the date it is enacted.
